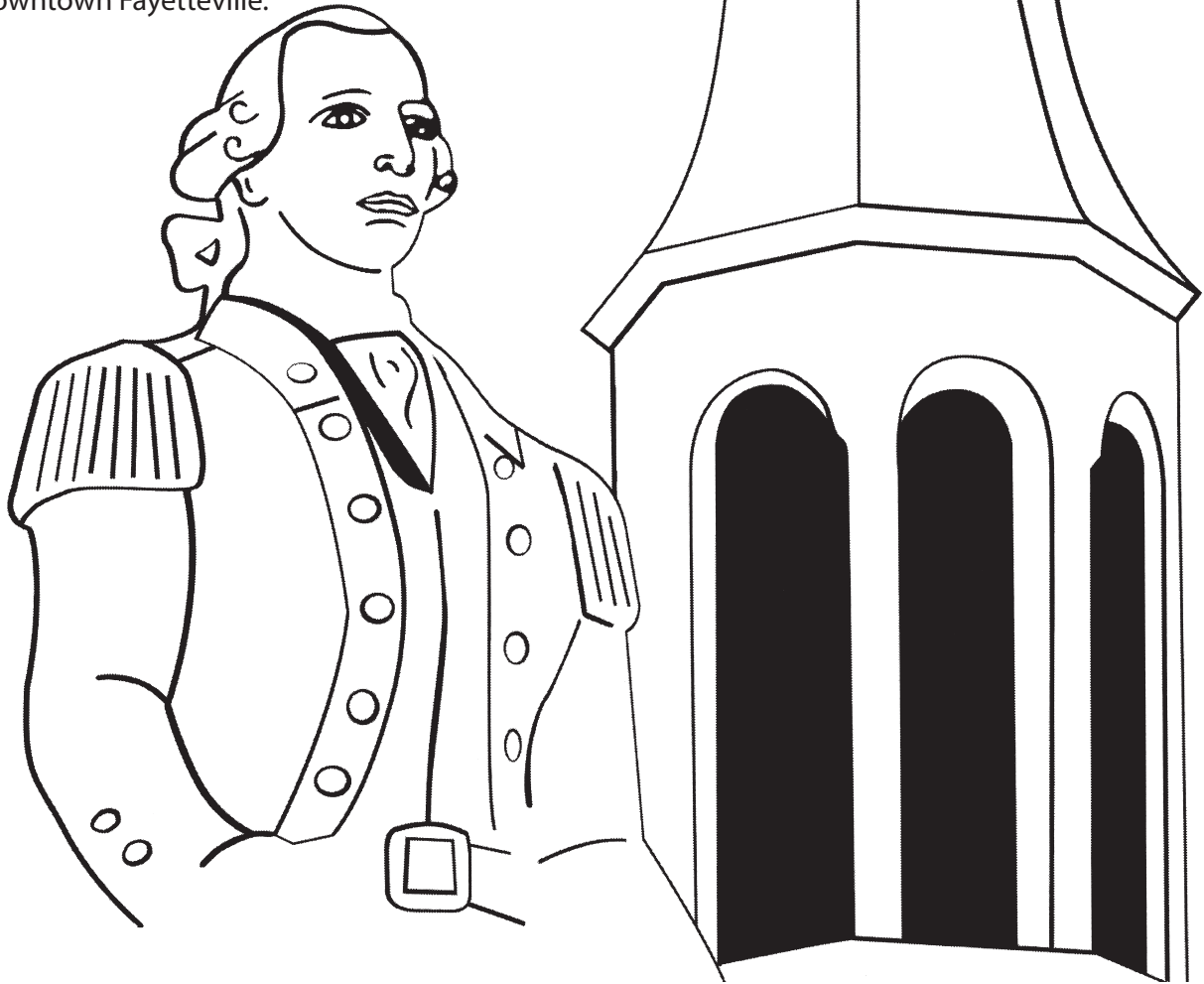


Marquis de Lafayette Statue
